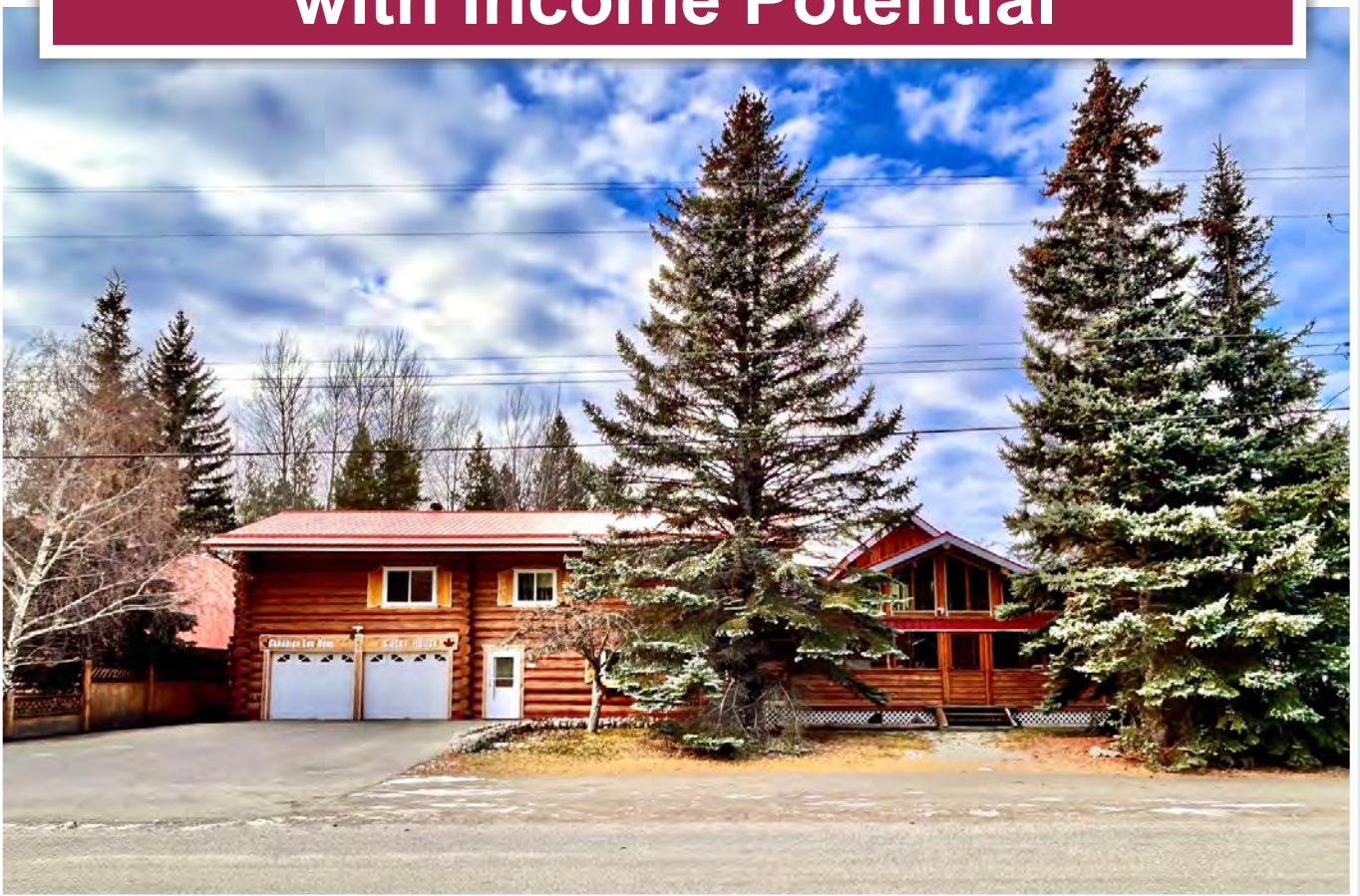

Valemount is easily accessible by road, located along Highway 5 (the Yellowhead Highway), approximately 320 kilometres north of Kamloops and 120 kilometres south of Jasper, Alberta. If you're driving from Vancouver, it's about a 7-hour drive northeast, and from Edmonton, it's a 5-hour drive west. For those traveling by air, the nearest major airport is in Prince George, about a 3-hour drive to the northwest, or in Kamloops to the south. Additionally, there are regional bus services and a small local airport for private planes, making Valemount accessible for both road trippers and air travelers.

Enjoy exclusive access to pristine runs and fresh snow on Mica Mountain, a 2,855-meter-elevation (9,367-foot) mountain summit offering both open bowl and naturally-gladed tree skiing.

Elevate your adventure with heli-skiing in Valemount, and experience the most remote and breathtaking mountain terrain. Discover vast, untouched powder and exhilarating descents for the ultimate downhill experience. Or fly your ski group to a remote cabin for a ski adventure.

There are plenty of trails for snowshoeing and cross-country skiing around Valemount, including maintained paths at Jackman Flats Provincial Park and Mount Robson Provincial Park.

Ice Fishing

Yellowhead Lake, Moose Lake, or Shere Lake are great for ice fishing fans who want to catch all kinds of fish, especially types of trout. Bring your auger and cut a hole December through early March when conditions permit.

Year-round Recreation

ATV & Off-Roading

The mountainous terrain surrounding Valemount is excellent for ATV and off-roading adventures, offering various forest roads and backcountry trails to explore.

Scenic Flights

Helicopter and plane tours are available to view the breathtaking landscapes, especially Mount Robson, glaciers, and the surrounding wilderness.
